

#### **Course Introduction**

There are various provisions in the Companies Act 2016 ("the Act") and the Constitution of a company that confers wide powers of management to its Directors. The role of a Director and Shareholder is not the same and the Shareholders do play an important role in relation to their control over the company and the exercise of the board's powers indirectly through its power of appointment or restriction in powers as prescribed in the Constitution.

# **Course objectives**

This course aims to outline the legal position of shareholders in a company, the pitfalls, the precautions that can be taken and what can be done if relationship between shareholders and relationship with the Company Directors turn sour.
