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Introduction

Company secretaries are familiar with the issuance of shares, alteration of a company's share capital and distribution of dividends as these areas are almost routine work. However, what many company directors and shareholders don't realize is that these areas are regulated by the Companies Act 2016 and the procedures and processes are onerous and could incur liabilities for them. Company secretaries must be familiar with the legal provisions governing these areas to enable them to advise the Board and shareholders competently.

Course Contents

- A step-by-step guide to issuing shares, including Directors' authority for the issue of shares and pre-emption rights in Table A vs. Section 85

- Reduction of capital
- The reasons for and procedure for buybacks out of profits and out of capital
- Declaring dividends

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
