Introduction

Section 62 of the Companies Act 1965 provided that a company if so authorized by its articles may in general meeting alter its share capital by various means including the cancellation of shares which at the date of the passing of the resolution in that behalf have not been taken or agreed to be taken by any person and diminish the amount of its share capital by the amount of the shares so cancelled. What has changed in the Companies Act 2016 compared to the 1965 Act?.

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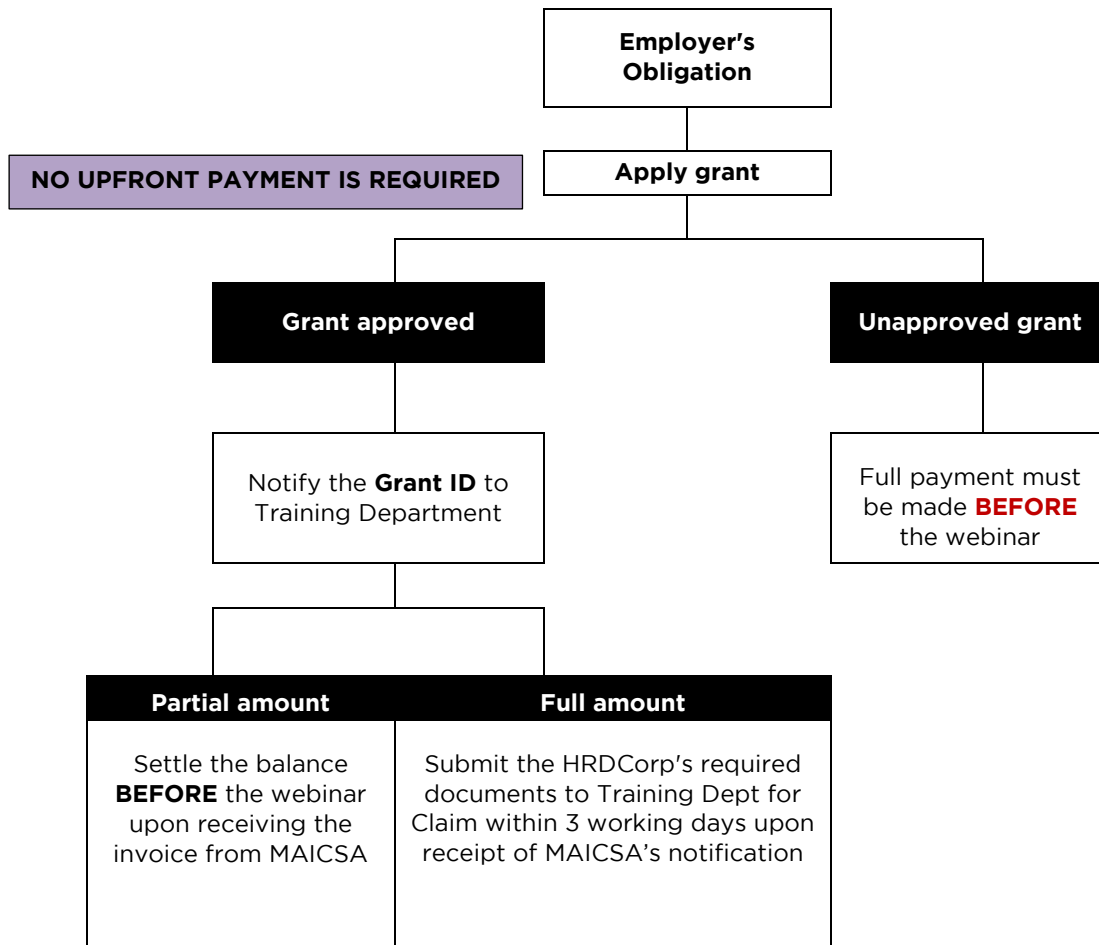
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
